# LEARNING PARTNERS...

## RC MANAGEMENT TEAMS

### RC MASTERS

As the leader of the RC Management Team and overall in-charge of an RC, the RC Master builds the College's identity by designing and implementing educational initiatives based on the RC theme. Each Master leads their team in building a creative and inclusive learning culture at the RCs. The Master is also responsible for handling residents' disputes, student conduct, and emergencies at the RCs.

### ASSOCIATE MASTERS

The Associate Master is another leader of the team who assists the RC Master in carrying out a wide range of duties to shape and build the RC community. They regularly participate in RC events and encourage greater student involvement. Additionally, the Associate Master deals with residents' disputes, student conduct, and emergencies at the RC.

### RESIDENT TUTORS

The Resident Tutors at the University are faculty and staff members, or postgraduate students. Their role is to provide pastoral care and engage residents through activities and daily interactions. They oversee one or two floors, supervise the Floor Ambassadors, and act as the first point of contact for residents. If you have any questions, suggestions, or concerns, feel free to seek advice from them.

### RC FELLOWS

RC Fellows are faculty members who actively engage with a particular Residential College (RC). Each Fellow affiliates with an RC and works closely with the RC Master to develop residential programmes.

Fellows do not live at the RCs, but they are important learning partners to the residents. They participate in or organise RC events and provide students with advice on study, career, and personal development.



The Student Affairs Office (SAO) has designated staff members who promote and enhance the living and learning experiences of students. They obtain opinions and suggestions from students and other members of RCs to implement and refine overall RC policies.

### RESIDENTIAL COLLEGES AND ACCOMMODATIONS SECTION, SAO

Under the Student Affairs Office, the Residential Colleges and Accommodations Section (RCAS) is responsible for the overall management of the RCs, including:

- Handling admission and allocation of all RCs;
- Managing the facilities and amenities of the site;
- Overseeing daily operational matters, such as security, cleaning service and maintenance.

### RC SYSTEM AND EDUCATION TEAM, SAO

The RC System and Education Team supports individual RCs in educational programmes, Advisory Boards, Executive Committees, and other administration. The team works closely with student leaders of the RCs. They also coordinate joint-RC and inter-RC education programmes.

### SERVICE WORKERS

Security, cleaners, technicians and other operational staff are staff who keep the RCs safe and clean. Security service is available 24/7 and a designated security station is located at the lobby of each RC.




# RC-THEMED CREDIT BEARING MODULE

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The RCs have incorporated four RC-themed credit-bearing modules as part of the significant segments of residential education. These modules empower student residents to explore the RC themes intellectually and benefit from them. Depending on the nature and content of the modules, some classes are physically hosted at the RCs.

Certain number of quota are reserved for RC residents. A priority registration prior to the University's Main Round of Module Registration is arranged, and the seats are offered on a first-come-first-served basis.



# DEVELOPING STUDENT LEADERSHIP

## RESIDENTIAL LIFE ASSISTANT

Residential Life Assistant (RLA) is newly established in 2024 to provide an opportunity for developing student residents' leadership and cultivating the sense of commitment to the development of RCs.

RLAs would undergo pre-service and on-the-job trainings. They would work with RC Management Team and Student Affairs Office on maintaining the Residential Colleges as a safe, warm and supportive living-learning community.



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## RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS

Residents' Associations (RAs) are resident-elected organisations. Each RA is responsible for building a sense of belonging and identity across the RC by organising activities. RAs work closely with the RC Management Team in building the RC community.



## SUSTAINABILITY LEADERS

Sustainability Leaders promote green messages to the general public and within our RC community, while also gaining practical experience in conservation efforts.

After a series of training, the Leaders will organise self-initiated campaigns for the RC communities and HSUHK. Our previous initiatives include:

- Coastal Cleaning
- Leading eco-tours for HSUHK members and the general public
- Outreach education talk
- Designing eco-map of Mui Tsz Lam
- Corporate visit

## FLOOR AMBASSADORS SCHEME

Floor Ambassador (FA) is a volunteer role in the RCs whose goal is to promote the bonding and cultivate a supportive network among residents of the same floor.

FAs will be nominated by Resident Tutors, who have a better understanding on the pulse and dynamics of the residential floors.

The recruitment of FAs takes place in September each year, with the flexibility to add or replace FAs anytime during the semester. Stay tuned to our announcements!



## MENTORSHIP SCHEME FOR NON-LOCAL STUDENTS

The Mentorship Scheme aims at nurturing senior students to serve as mentors for non-local undergraduate year 1 students living off-campus. Each mentor is responsible for initiating regular gatherings with a small group of non-local freshmen as well as providing guidance and support to ensure a smooth transition for freshmen into Hong Kong in all aspects of their daily lives. Throughout the scheme, non-local freshmen will receive timely assistance when adjusting to new living and learning environments, while mentors will develop their leadership qualities and empathy.



## FIRE SAFETY MARSHAL PROGRAMME

The programme aims to promote fire safety in the RC community through different initiatives such as organising educational campaigns and assisting in fire drills.

Serving as a Fire Safety Marshal not only acquires fire safety knowledge but also get yourself involved in the RCs before taking up a more sophisticated role.

## FLAGSHIP EVENTS

### THE COUNCIL CHAIRMAN BOWL

With generous support from the Council Chairman Dr the Honourable Moses Cheng, The Council Chairman Bowl was launched in 2017/18 and it has been one of the most popular events.

The Bowl aims at fostering inter-RC interaction, sportsmanship and team spirit among RC members. Members of the RCs, including student residents, non-residential Members, RC Management Teams, and RC Fellows, participate in inter-RC competitions to fight for the glory of their RC.



### HIGH TABLE DINNERS

Among various RC events, High Table Dinner best represent the RC's collegiate system and tradition. All participants, including students, faculty, and guests, will wear a college gown.

A Keynote Speaker is invited to give a speech on a topic that interlinks the theme of the respective RC.

Participants will then enjoy a seated dinner and engage in meaningful conversations with each other.

High Table Dinners are either exclusive to an RC or on joint-RC basis.
